

Quick Reference for Parents

<p>SCHOOL ENTRY</p> <p>All students will enter in the front parking lot on Capitola Rd. Ext.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Gr. K-8 will enter through the gym doors. • Between 7:45 and 8:15, students will be seated with 6 ft distancing in their stable groups. 	<p>SCHOOL ENTRY</p> <p>Upon being admitted students will:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • At 8:15, stable groups will be taken to their classroom by their teacher. • 6 ft social distancing will be maintained. 	<p>SCHOOL ENTRY</p> <p>Upon being admitted students will:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Gr. K-8 will line up at marked intervals inside the gym/ outside of the classroom and be admitted 1 at a time into the classroom.
<p>PERSONAL BELONGINGS</p> <p>Each student will be provided with 5-gallon zip-lock bag in which to store their personal belongings: clothing/shoes, fleece blankets, gloves, hats, etc</p> <p>Note: Each student must bring a closable water bottle each day. Drinking fountains cannot be used and cups will not be distributed. Water will be dispensed at filling stations only.</p> <p>Students will sanitize hands prior to filling bottles.</p>	<p>ARRIVAL TIME</p> <p>Staff will begin health checks while students are in cars at 7:45 am.</p> <p>Students may not get out of the car prior to the health check.</p> <p>Staff will not be in the parking lot prior to 7:45.</p> <p>Students must wait in the car until cleared for school entry. Health checks will be done as quickly as is safe and possible.</p>	<p>LEAVING SCHOOL</p> <p>Students will be lined up at 6 ft intervals outside of the classroom. P/U is between 3:15 and 3:30.</p> <p>Friday Pick-up is at 12:15 pm.</p> <p>Pick-up is in the back parking lot. Students will be dismissed by family groups to parent/guardians cars.</p> <p>Staff on outside duty will communicate parent/guardian arrival to teachers via walkie-talkie.</p> <p>After-care cannot be provided due to stable group requirements.</p>

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<p>FACE COVERINGS</p> <p>The CA Department of Health guidance requires children in grades K-12 to <u>wear face coverings in school, except while eating/drinking.</u></p> <p>School staff will wear masks/shields at all times.</p> <p>Social Distancing will be practiced during eating or drinking in the classroom or outside of the classroom.</p>	<p>PHYSICAL DISTANCING</p> <p>COVID-19 spreads mainly among people who are in close contact for a prolonged period.</p> <p>We will ensure that students, parents, and school staff maintain a 6ft distance from each other to minimize the risk of spread at school.</p> <p>Staff may come closer to a student if necessary for health or safety.</p>	<p>HEALTH SCREENING</p> <p>Staff and students are required to take their temperature and be aware of symptoms before leaving home. <u>Stay at home if your temperature is 100.4 or above.</u></p> <p>Staff and students will be screened (temp. & symptoms) prior to school entry. Students will be screened before leaving the car prior to entering school or boarding the school bus.</p>
<p>HAND WASHING AND HYGIENE</p> <p>School staff will teach and reinforce proper handwashing technique. We will have touch-free hand sanitizer throughout the school.</p> <p>Students will sanitize hands on a schedule throughout the school day.</p>	<p>STABLE GROUPS</p> <p>Classrooms will form stable groups of 12 or less students.</p> <p>Students will remain in their class groups throughout the day and will not interact with students from other classrooms. This minimizes the risk of potential virus spread throughout the school.</p>	<p>BREAKS AND LUNCH</p> <p>Classrooms will remain in stable groups and maintain social distancing during breaks and lunch.</p> <p>Classes may eat in the classroom or outdoors if weather allows.</p> <p>Stable class groups and distancing will be maintained during breaks.</p>
